I come to you bringing some information regarding the radio work [Christians Broadcasting Hope] in Côte d'Ivoire. But first, I thank everyone who gave money to support this work so lives can be won for the Lord. May God bless you and remember your sacrifices and gifts for his cause. By the grace of the Lord, the programs that we produce are really appreciated by the listeners, evidenced by the feedback and encouragement that we received from them.

I communicated with a young woman who after listening to our program on marriage contacted me to explain the failures she was experiencing in her romantic relationship. We had time to pray together, and I gave her some advice to follow so she will have a good relationship with the Lord. I recommended to her that she be open with her pastor so he can also support her in prayer.

In addition to this, we have had many other cases, some of which I would like to mention:

I had a young man from Yamoussoukro who contacted us and wanted us to pray for him that he will quit smoking. Another person from Abidjan had a problem in their home that was addressed by our program. I prayed for another person to be freed from evil spirits in his life. Another asked for the program to help his youth. I prayed for a person in Dabou for spiritual support. I also received several encouragements on the Facebook page, and we had many people who asked us to pray for them about the situations they were experiencing.

Sauti Ya Bwana ("Voice of the Lord"), comes from Kima, Kenya, and reaches Swahili-speaking souls across the country.




#### **FRENCH**

## **Christians Broadcasting Hope in Swahili**

The Christians Broadcasting Hope (CBH) Swahili program was established in East Africa, Kenya, for the purpose of broadcasting the message of Christ Jesus with the Hope that it brings out a hundredfold. We prepare various programs (preaching, teaching, counseling, etc.) to meet the needs, interests, and preference of about 10 million people in western Kenya, Nyanza, Rift Valley, and Uganda. Through these programs, those who listen have expressed their gratifications, that they were sick and God healed them, were preparing to commit suicide but were saved, they were neglected by their parents but God has given them refuge, families were breaking apart but God has held them together once more, students

were experiencing difficulties in paying school fees but God has opened financial doors for them. There are many thanksgivings being expressed for the Hope of Jesus taking us through life.

Often our engagement with listeners is on-going. Currently our CBH Swahili prayer team in Kenya is praying for a one-year old boy called Adrian, who was diagnosed and determined that he has a hole in the heart. A specialist doctor who deals with hearts expressed that the boy needs urgent surgery before it's worse. The hospital is requesting many Kenyan shillings for this. The boy's mother had her pregnancy while in college and stopped attending classes. The father of the boy has never shown any interest in

helping her or the child from this, a poor family. The girl told CBH Swahili team that she was dialing a radio channel and she heard preaching going on at West FM and was convinced to surrender her life to Christ. She has never stopped listening to our program. She told us that since she gave birth to this boy, he never stopped crying and sweating terribly, but she believes that God is able to heal the boy.

Thank you so much for partnering with us to bring Hope to people like this who are searching. God bless you for your gifts and prayers.
